### Knollwood Turns Fifty-Three

In worship this Sunday we joyously celebrate a birthday—Knollwood's birthday. It was fifty-three years ago that a small group of pioneers set out to establish a new and different kind of Baptist church on Knollwood Street. There was no I-40 (although on Knollwood's earliest plans, I-40 does show up as a dotted line for proposed new highway), no Thruway Shopping Center, and not even the now-late Knollwood Street K&W.

But there was a Jack Noffsinger (who will join us Sunday in singing the hymn he wrote for our 25th birthday celebration), there was a Leon and Fordie Rice (whose granddaughter Sara recently joined the choir), and there were many dozen charter members (many of whom continue to worship with us each week).

And there were the great hymns of the church that we continue to sing today. On Sunday, as part of John Ness Beck's anthem "Thou Art God," we sing Isaac Watts' hymn "O God, Our Help in Ages Past." This paraphrase of Psalm 90 was published in his 1719 collection *The Psalms of David Imitated*

will work. I will personally make it happen."

He was surprised. "You would do that?" I told him yes and that any minister here would. We talked for about ten minutes and exchanged contact information. He and I are to meet for lunch and get him introduced into one of the groups.

His thoughts about the institutional church were revealing – especially his conversations with several churches as he called around. One day we as a church ought to talk about this. In the meantime, let us find inspiration from those, like us, who are searching for meaning – but in different ways and places and times. We are up to it!

**WORSHIP WISE** *from page 1 in the Language of the New Testament.* Here Watts paraphrased the entire Psalter (save the dozen that he deemed unsuited for Christian worship).

To get you started, here are the first two verses of Psalm 90, followed by Watts' paraphrase:

Psalm 90:1-2

Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations. Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Watts:

O God, our help in ages past,  
Our hope for years to come,  
Our shelter from the stormy blast,  
And our eternal home.

Before the hills in order stood,  
Or earth received her frame,  
From everlasting Thou art God,  
To endless years the same.

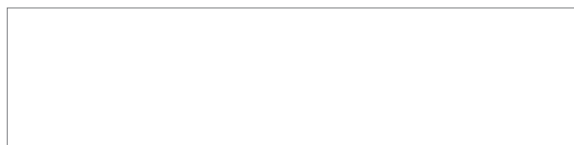

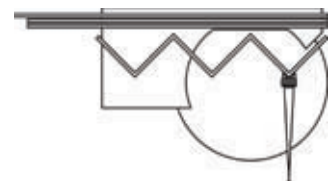
