#### **LECTIONARY NOTES**

**Isaiah 6:1-8:** Isaiah records the experience of his calling in the temple when the "holy things" came "alive."

**1 Corinthians 15:1-11:** Paul seeks to establish the doctrinal foundations he had laid at the church in Corinth with a particular focus on the resurrection of Jesus, to which he was a witness.

**Luke 5:1-11:** A sudden miraculous catch of fish in deep water reveals the divine power of Jesus; and Simon (Peter), James and John leave everything to follow him.

**FOR THE CHILDREN** - Worship and educational activities are provided for children during the worship hour each week. Worship Care is provided for preschool aged children on the first floor of Building B. A children's worship activity is provided for children in kindergarten through third grade. These children may meet their leaders in Building B and sit together for the first part of the worship service, or they may sit with their families. All children who are participating in children's worship will leave the sanctuary during the last stanza of the second hymn to continue with their own worship experience.
